
## Sillosocks Hypa-Flap Decoys




## **Assembly Instructions**

- **1.** Carefully remove the elastic band from around the body of your Sillosocks Hypa-Flap decoy and unravel the wings.
- 2. Remove the Hypa-Flap wing spars /rods from their \*packaging (each Hypa-Flap comes complete with 2 rods 1 for immediate use and 1 for a spare). insert a wing spar through the front of the corrugated body and then feed it over the top of the wing then under the wing spar tab and back out onto the top of the wing. Repeat this step for the other wing.

Wing rod inserted right through the front of the corrugated body





Over the wing, under the tab and out again

**3.** Then feed one of the ends into the terminal pocket at the end of one of the wings and repeat on the other side.

Wing rod inserted through the tip of the corrugated body



**4.** Finally, bend or curl the wing tips upwards a little and fold the leading edge of both wings upwards just in front of the wing spars to allow the air to flow over them correctly. The use of a speed controller is highly recommended as it will allow you to control the rate of flap according to the prevailing wind.

Troubleshooting: If the outside wing flaps more than the inside wing tilt the Hypa-Flap inwards and vice versa

Your Pigeon Hypa-Flap Decoy is now ready to use! You can secure them onto the arms of Pigeon magnet Rotary Machines quickly and easily using the thumb screw to secure them into place.

\*Please look carefully in your packaging for your Hypa-Flap wing spars / rods as these are often well packed in cardboard, bubble wrap and packing paper and can be easily misplaced!
